#### **MITIGATION**

Any activity taken to eliminate or reduce the degree of long-term risk to human life, property, and the environment

#### PREPAREDNESS

Any activity taken in advance of a disaster that reduces a community's vulnerability, mitigates the impact, or enables one to respond more efficiently.

#### RESPONSE

Any action taken immediately before, during, or directly after a disaster occurs to save lives, minimize injuries, lessen property and environmental damage and enhance the effectiveness of recovery.

#### RECOVERY

A short-term activity to return vital life support systems to minimum operating standards and/ or a long-term activity designed to return the affected people and areas to their pre-disaster conditions.
