b. Schroeder Fire review

- 500 homes evacuated; 1 destroyed and some outbuildings; burned 2,000 acres
- No long term needs yet
- Good response by Red Cross, Salvation Army and Helpline
- Lead to an effort to create a COAD in Rapid City to better serve the community
- Also efforts to engage Emergency Managers in West River so they know how to reach out
- Perkins fire burned 12,000 acres
- Jones Fire burned 9900 acres

c. SD OEM update

- COVID 19 several counties still have Substantial Community Spread not out of the woods yet
- Hospital capacity is at 48%
- 50% of population have at least 1 dose
- Drought situation all counties have at least some level of drought; forecast is for less precipitation than normal
- Wildland fires are a major concern 53 fires so far this year
- Next week is Severe Weather Week is next week April 19th April 24th

 - Launched a new Funeral Assistance Program for COVID related deaths
